Last year Peter came back older and wiser but with the same energy and determination. We hired him back to manage our sustainability department. He is taking that project on with the same tenacity. He's married now with kids and has the same fire for God and ministry. He still inspires me to pray and seek God, but I haven't quite reached that 4:30 am prayer time yet.
